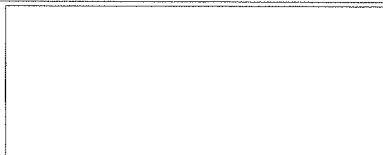

Background Summary of CIA activities at Abu Ghurayb Prison

- Abu Ghurayb Prison holds circa 8,000 - 10,000 prisoners. Most of prisoners are held for routine criminal violations (e.g., theft, assault, manslaughter). A small number are held in the isolation unit, circa 100. The U.S. Military runs the prison with the assistance of Iraqi guards. [redacted]

The select oversight committees have been notified of the investigation. (We believe that the photo of the deceased prisoner shown on 60 Minutes is Al-Jamaidi.)

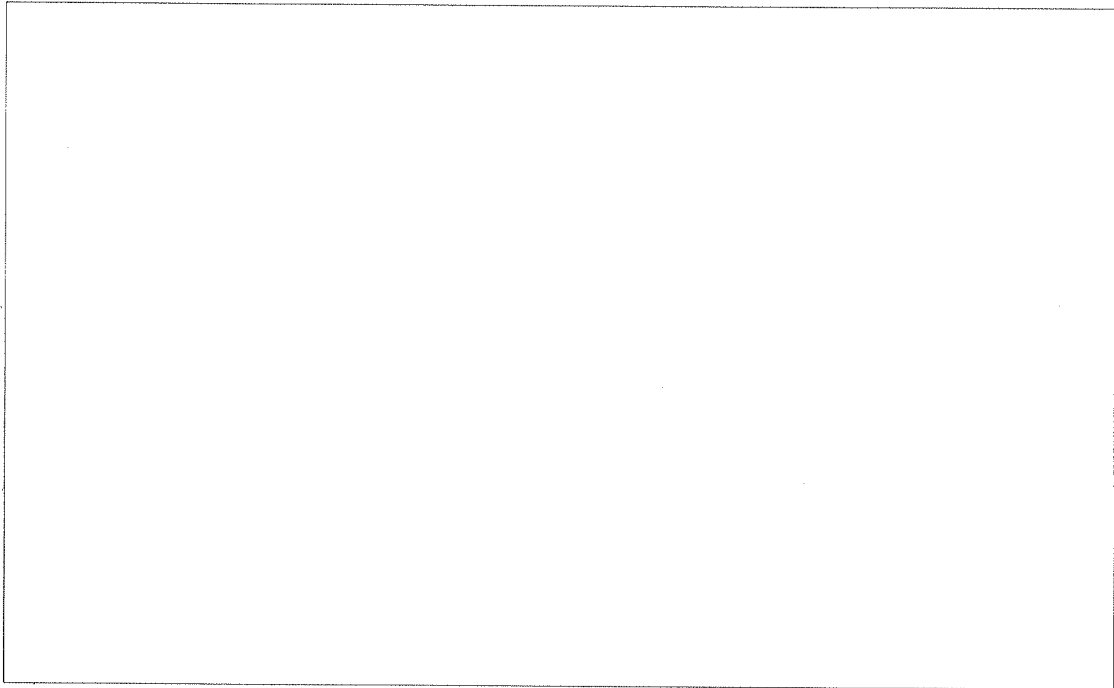
■ [redacted] Iraqi General Abed Hamed Mowhoush died while in DOD custody and there are allegation that physical abuse may have been a factor in his death. [redacted]

[redacted] OIG, in conjunction with DOD, is investigating whether the Agency had any involvement with the death. The select oversight committees have been notified of the investigation.
