OFFENSE/TYPE OF INFORMATION: Criminal Information - Maltreatment of Prisoners

SYNOPSIS:

a. Reference: Significant Data File 0051-04-CID259

b. Source of Information: The information in this report was extracted from the aforementioned reference, and is considered reliable.

c. On 8 Mar 2004, SPC [REDACTED] E Section, Joint Interrogation and Debriefing Center (JIDC), Abu Ghurayb Prison, IZ, reported that Detainee [REDACTED] National Detainee Reporting System (NDRS) Number [REDACTED] alleged he was physically abused by soldiers who appeared to be Military Police (MP) while at Camp Baghdad, IZ.

According to Detainee [REDACTED] Coalition Forces (CF) detained him when he entered Iraq from Saudi Arabia. CF took Detainee [REDACTED] to a camp near the border town of Araar, IZ. Detainee [REDACTED] was not mistreated at that camp or anywhere else until he arrived a few days later to an unknown camp in Al-Baghdadi, IZ. Detainee [REDACTED] said he was not mistreated the first evening, however, the next day soldiers tortured him. The soldiers ordered him to run, squat and stand up as fast as he could for one hour. The soldiers tied a "mineral water box" to his chest and another to his back, and ordered him to squat and stand up for a long period of time. Detainee [REDACTED] informed them he was an old man and that he was 47 years old, and I could not do the movements. After which, the soldiers tied his legs to his hands and left him. Late on, a soldier came and stood on his back and kicked him in a "sensitive organ" on his body. The soldier also kicked him in the face with his shoe. Detainee [REDACTED] alleged soldiers made him lean on a wall, and then two soldiers came and kicked him with their shoes. Detainee [REDACTED] claimed he fell down several times, and was wounded in the face as a result of his falling. Detainee [REDACTED] complained of soreness to his lower limbs, and had severe pain in his right and left arms as a result of beating. An "American" officer supposedly witnessed the beating, and he stopped the torture and brought a doctor to check Detainee [REDACTED]. The doctor allegedly administered some form of medication to Detainee [REDACTED]. On the second day, soldiers tied his legs to "mineral water boxes" and ordered him to walk and drag the boxes. An

"American" corporal supposedly stopped the abuse, so the soldiers untied the water boxes from him and ordered him to squat, stand up and shout for a long period of time. Afterwards, they brought several detainees together and ordered them to make a circle, and put Detainee [REDACTED] inside the circle. They ordered them to slap Detainee [REDACTED] on the back of his neck and on his face, and said to them, "this is an Iranian, to let them beat me more."

CPT [REDACTED] 49th Medical Detachment, Baghdad Correctional Confinement Facility, Abu Ghryeb, IZ, examined Detainee [REDACTED] and detailed the detainee's injuries in a medical report at the prison.

d. The information in this report is intended to alert the theatre CID elements about the incident, and index the information at the Criminal Intelligence Branch, HQUSACIDC.

e. This is a terminal report. No further reports are contemplated unless additional criminal information is received regarding this matter.
