(U) SUBJECT: Allegation of Detainee Abuse

6(7)(c)-1 (LES//FOUO) During an interview conducted on 3 June 2004, by Guantanamo Bay, Cuba it was alleged by tortured by U.S. interrogators.

- P(1)(C)-5 claims he was made to stand with his arms outstretched for three hours, then (LES//FOUO) forced to kneel until he had a heart problem and collapsed. He stated he was taken to the hospital, but the interrogator came and took him out. He said the interrogator told him he would not be allowed to return to the hospital until he had confessed that he was an Al Qaida member.
