The following actions are ongoing:

- o Provided Army OCLL with number of female detainees in custody at BCCF in November 2003 (3), currently held at BCCF (4) and the total since the facility opened (30).
- o Continue work on policy-doctrine-training cross walk in preparation for developing interim change to AR 190-8
