Ghraib, IZ, reported alleged he was abused while detained by U.S. Forces at an unknown location. (U) On 22 Jul 04, was interviewed and alleged he was captured on 14 May 04. and taken to a detention facility called "Tarak Base", located near Fallujah, IZ, where he stated he was not abused at this location. stayed for six days. transferred to a facility he called "The Farm" which he stated was between Ramadi and alleged during an interrogation at "The Farm" a male interrogator grabbed him by his hair, pulled him to the floor and pulled his head back so far he could not breathe. then stated the male released him and the interrogation ended stated no abuse occurred after this incident. white, short blonde hair, wearing tan pants and brown t-shirt and with a tattoo of a bird. possibly an eagle, on his upper left arm. (U) Investigation to date has determined was captured by Weapons Company, 1st Battalion, 5th Marines. A Request For Assistance (RFA) was forwarded to the Naval Criminal Investigative Service (NCIS) to review the detainee records pertaining to NCIS reported was never taken to "The Farm" or "Tarak Base"; however he was interrogated at Camp Fallujah, IZ, by a Marine interrogator. NCIS reported the Tactical Interrogation Reports were reviewed and there was no indication of abuse noted; however, the NCIS report is not clear on whether or not the interrogator was interviewed. remained in the custody of U.S. Navy or Marine Corp personnel until his transfer to BCCF. It is strongly believed that if the alleged offenses occurred they were perpetrated by members of the U.S. Navy or Marine Corps. All US Army leads have been exhausted; therefore, this investigation is referred to the NCIS for action deemed appropriate. 

He stated at this location, no abuse occurred. He was then transferred to a US controlled detention facility called "The Farm". He stated this location was located on a farm between Ramadi and Fallujah. He stated after he processed into the facility, he was unhooded and hands untied. He was placed into a cell, which he described as having sandbag walls and wooden roof. On the evening of the sixth day at this facility, he was taken to a metal conex, which contained a brown metal table and two white plastic chairs. He said he was sat in a chair in front of the table. A female linguist, with a Lebanese dialect was sitting behind the table. A young, white male interrogator with short blond hair, tan pants, and and the tale. He stated the male had a tattoo of a brown t-shirt leaned on the table between bird, possibly an eagle, on his upper left arm. He stated the male placed his foot between legs against his grown. He stated the male was not pressing against his grown. 

6. INVESTIGATIVE SUMMARY: THE INFORMATION IN THIS REPORT IS BASED UPON AN ALLEGATION OR PRELIMINARY INVESTIGATION AND MAY CHANGE PRIOR TO THE COMPLETION OF THE INVESTIGATION. THIS IS AN "OPERATION IRAQI FREEDOM" INVESTIGATION.

3RD STATUS:

THIS STATUS REPORT WAS GENERATED TO REFER THIS INVESTIGATION TO THE UNITED STATES NAVY CRIMINAL INVESTIGATION SERVICE (NCIS) FOR COMPLETION.

THIS INVESTIGATION IS BEING FORWARDED TO NCIS AS THE INVESTIGATION TO DATE HAS DETERMINED THE ALLEGATION OF ABUSE DID NOT OCCUR WHILE THE DETAINEE WAS IN THE CUSTODY OF ARMY PERSONNEL. IT IS BELIEVED THAT IF THE ALLEGED OFFENSES OCCURRED THEY WERE PERPETRATED BY MEMBERS OF THE US NAVY OR MARINE CORPS. ALL US ARMY LEADS HAVE BEEN EXHAUSTED; THEREFORE, THIS INVESTIGATION IS REFERRED TO THE NCIS FOR ACTION DEEMED APPROPRIATE.

ON 22 JUL 04. WAS INTERVIEWED AND ALLEGED HE WAS CAPTURED ON 14 MAY 04, AND TAKEN TO A DETENTION FACILITY CALLED "TARAK BASE", NEAR FALLUJAH WHERE HE STAYED FOR SIX DAYS. STATED HE WAS NOT ABUSED AT THIS LOCATION. WAS THEN TRANSFERRED TO A FACILITY HE CALLED "THE FARM" WHICH HE STATED WAS BETWEEN RAMADI AND FALLUJAH. ALLEGED DURING AN INTERROGATION WHILE AT "THE FARM" A MALE INTERROGATOR GRABBED HIM BY HIS HAIR AND PULLED HIM TO THE FLOOR AND PULLED HIS HEAD BACK SO FAR HE COULD NOT BREATHE. THEN STATED THE MALE RELEASED HIM AND THE INTERROGATION ENDED STATED NO ABUSE OCCURRED AFTER THIS INCIDENT. DESCRIBED THE MALE INTERROGATOR AS WHITE, SHORT BLONDE HAIR, WEARING TAN PANTS AND BROWN T-SHIRT WITH A TATTOO OF A BIRD, POSSIBLY AN EAGLE, ON HIS UPPER LEFT ARM.

INVESTIGATION TO DATE HAS DETERMINED WAS CAPTURED BY WEAPONS COMPANY, 1ST BATTALION, 5TH MARINES. A REQUEST FOR ASSISTANCE WAS FORWARDED TO THE NAVAL CRIMINAL INVESTIGATIVE SERVICE (NCIS) TO REVIEW THE DETAINEE RECORDS PERTAINING TO NCIS REPORTED WAS NEVER TAKEN TO "THE FARM" OR "TARAK BASE", HOWEVER HE WAS INTERROGATED AT CAMP FALLUJAH, IZ, BY A MARINE INTERROGATOR. NCIS REPORTED THE TACTICAL

INTERROGATION REPORTS WERE REVIEWED AND THERE WAS NO INDICATION OF ABUSE NOTED; HOWEVER, THE NCIS REPORT IS NOT CLEAR ON WHETHER OR NOT THE INTERROGATOR WAS INTERVIEWED.

THIS INVESTIGATION WAS INITIATED UPON RECEIPT OF A MEMORANDUM OF TRANSMITTAL (MOT) (0096-04-CID789) FROM BAGHDAD CENTRAL CONFINEMENT FACILITY THAT MR REPORTED HE WAS ABUSED WHILE DETAINED AT A CONFINEMENT FACILITY CALLED "THE FARM".

PRELIMINARY INVESTIGATION REVEALED PERSON(S) UNKNOWN ALLEGEDLY ABUSED MR. BY PHYSICALLY ASSAULTING HIM DURING AN INTERROGATION AT THE FARM.

ON 22 JUN 04, MR. WAS INTERVIEWED WHEREIN HE STATED HE WAS CAPTURED BY U.S. FORCES, TAKEN TO AN UNKNOWN DETENTION FACILITY WHERE HE WAS SUBSEQUENTLY ABUSED BY AN INTERROGATOR. MR. STATED HIS INTERROGATOR WAS A WHITE MALE WITH BLONDE HAIR DRESSED IN TAN PANTS AND A BROWN T-SHIRT WITH A BIRD TATTOO ON HIS LEFT ARM.





We currently have approximately 50 open actions, ranging from a slap in the face to deaths. We are required on a weekly basis to provide investigative updates to CID Command, who in turn briefs the SECDEF, at the end of the week. It has been nothing less than a great challenge identifying whether or not the detainees are providing false information, as you can probably imagine. Our office consists of five agents. We do some traveling in the local area, but are limited.

At this point, we have identified at least one case where the alleged victim related he was allegedly abused. During the process of the investigation, we have to obtain all detainee records, to include interrogation records, complete interviews of the alleged victims, alleged suspects of the abuse and any other investigative activity which might be appropriate. In this particular instance, the individual in question is representations and the National Detainee Reporting Number is Mr. Alleged stated he was captured on 14 May 04 and transferred to a facility called "The Farm" located between Ramadi and Fallujah.

stated he was hooded and placed i<u>n a cell with sandbag walls and a wooden roof and left there for six</u> days. On the evening of the sixth day, Mr. stated he was taken to a metal connex, which contained a brown metal table and two white plastic chairs. Mr. related he was sat at the table. Mr female linguist, with a Lebanese dialect, sitting behind the table. Mr. related the interrogator was a young: white male with short blond hair, tan pants and a bird, possibly an eagle, on his upper left arm. Mr during the interrogation, the man placed his foot between Mr. legs against his groin. Mr. man did not press his foot against Mr groin. Mr stated after a few minutes of questioning, the man by his hair and pulled him and the chair to the floor. Mr. grabbed Mr explained he landed on the floor next to the wall. Mr related the man pulled his head back so far that Mr. could not breathe. Mr. stated the man released him and the interrogation was over. Mr related no abuse occurred after this incident

Mr. could not provide any further descriptive information on the male or female who interrogated him.

This is the allegation that was sent to USACIDC Command about "The Farm."
