Mr. [redacted] alleged he was captured by U.S. Coalition Forces, taken to a palace in Ramadi, where he was subsequently kicked, electrocuted and struck on the neck by unknown U.S. Coalition soldier(s). Dr (1LT) [redacted] 391st Military Police Battalion, Detainee Aid Station, BCCF, IZ, related he had conducted a medical exam of Mr [redacted] when he arrived at BCCF, who related his allegations. Dr [redacted] related he had found no signs of abuse to Mr [redacted] but the abuse had occurred two months prior to his examination. *b6-4, b7c-4*

Investigation by this office established the United States Marine Corps (USMC) had operational control of the Ramadi area during the time frame of the alleged incident. Further, a review of the documentation provided by Detainee Operations, Camp Victory, Iraq, detailed Mr. [redacted] was in the custody of the United States Marine Corps, Weapons Company, 2/4 Marine Infantry Regiment until his transfer to BCCF on 18 June 2004. The review reflected Mr. [redacted] did not fall under the custody of the U.S. Army until 18 Jul 04 (Exhibit 6). *b6-4, b7c-4*

On 1 Mar 05, this investigation was transferred to the U.S. Naval Criminal Investigative Service, as all alleged abuse occurred while Mr. [redacted] was under custody of the United States Marine Corps. *b6-4, b7c-4*

DETAILS

BASIS FOR INVESTIGATION: On 18 Jun 04, this office was notified by the 391st Military Police (MP) Battalion (BN) Detainee Aid Station (DAS), Baghdad Central Confinement Facility (BCCF), Abu Ghruyeb, Iraq (AGI), that Detainee [REDACTED], National Detainee Reporting System (NDRS) [REDACTED] alleged he was abused while detained at the Ramadi Palace, prior to arriving at BCCF.

About 1300, 18 Jun 04, SA [REDACTED] received a medical screening report and physical, pertaining to [REDACTED] from the DAS, which detailed his allegation of abuse. (See Medical Screening Report and Physical)

About 1100, 23 Jun 04, SA [REDACTED], with the assistance of Linguist [REDACTED] this office, interviewed [REDACTED] in reference to his abuse allegation. He stated he was captured on 9-10 Apr 04 in the city of Ramadi by US Forces. He was taken to the "palace" in Ramadi for three days before he was transferred to a second location in Ramadi for 16 days. He was then transferred to a detention facility in Fallujah for about 30 days. He was then transferred back to the second location in Ramadi for 17 days. He was then transferred to BCCF. [REDACTED] alleged during his first three days of capture, while at the first location, he was abused each day. He alleged that the first night two men kicked him and poured water on his head. He described the first man as short, thin, and white, with a blond mustache and wearing civilian clothes. He said the man spoke Arabic and once told [REDACTED] "I'm British". He described the other man as short, thin, and white, with no facial hair and green eyes. [REDACTED] said on the second night, the two men came and took him to a room with a table. The two men held him down on the table, while the Arabic speaking man poured water in his face and on his body. He said that both men took turns shocking him several times on his abdomen area. He described the shocking instrument as about 1ft long and black. [REDACTED] said it looked like a flashlight. This is all that happened that night. On the third day, as he was in line to transfer, the Arabic speaking man approached him and struck him on the neck, causing him to fall down. [REDACTED] said that the men never really asked questions other than whether or not he was from Fallujah. When he arrived at the second location in Ramadi, he informed the interrogator about the abuse.

AGENT'S COMMENT: [REDACTED] could not write Arabic. This agent saw no signs or marks on the detainee's body, indicating the detainee had been shocked.

About 1200, 23 Jun 04, SA [REDACTED] interviewed 1LT (DR.) [REDACTED] 391st MP BN, DAS, BCCF, AGI, who stated he conducted the Medical Screening and Physical for [REDACTED]. He recalled [REDACTED] making the allegation of being electrocuted a couple of months ago, while detained at the Ramadi palace, but does not recall specifics. He noted that during the physical examination, no marks were visible indicating being electrocuted.

DETAILS

BASIS FOR INVESTIGATION: On 28 Jun 04, this office received a Memorandum of Transmittal (MOT) 0076-04-CID789, from the 75h Military Police Detachment (MP DET), Baghdad Central Confinement Facility (BCCF), Abu Gharib, IZ, that Mr [redacted] ISN [redacted] (NDRS [redacted]) reported he was abused while detained at Ramadi Palace; IZ, prior to detention at BCCF.

About 1000, 20 Feb 05, the undersigned conducted a thorough review of this investigation and determined the investigation demonstrates the detainee was not truthful about his allegations. The review indicates the investigation does not support U.S. Army investigative purview, supported by the following documents-

Exhibit 2 contains Sworn Statement of SSG [redacted] 2/4 Marine Infantry Regiment, 10 Apr 04, documenting the discovery of medical shears, a flashlight, both belonging to a KIA U.S. Navy Corpsman and weapons in Mr. [redacted] house, a Sworn Statement of SGT [redacted] 2/4 Marine Infantry Regiment, 10 Apr 04, documenting the discovery of medical shears, a flashlight, both belonging to a KIA U.S. Navy Corpsman and weapons in Mr. [redacted] house, and the Coalition Apprehension Form, 10 Apr 04, detailing Mr [redacted] was apprehended by Weapons Company, 2/4 Marine Infantry Regiment.

Exhibit 3 contains documentation of an interview with Mr. [redacted] conducted 23 Jun 04, in which Mr. [redacted] claimed the abuse occurred in Ramadi, IZ, during the time frame of 9 Apr 04 though 18 Jun 04.

Exhibit 4, Medical Screening Report, 12 Jun 04, reflecting Mr. [redacted] demeanor during his screening as calm. This document does not reflect any allegations of abuse by U.S Army personnel.

Agent's Comment: A review of the documentation reveals Mr [redacted] was referred to detainee 270, ABA0649, ISN [redacted] and NDRS [redacted] at several times in the course of his detention.

On 28 Jan 05, this office received an electronic message from SA [redacted] NCIS Little Creek, VA. SA [redacted] related the request for assistance received from our office had been completed and that NCIS Headquarters, Washington DC held the pertinent documents/information requested by this office.

SA [redacted] was provided as the Point of Contact for this information. The report number was listed as 17OCT04-MEJB-0471-7XMA.

To date all attempts at contacting SA [redacted] have met with negative results. It is strongly believed that if the alleged offenses occurred they were perpetrated by members of the US Navy or Marine Corps. All US Army leads have been exhausted; therefore, this investigation is referred to the NCIS for action deemed appropriate.

Based on the above review, it was determined that Mr [redacted] was under control of the United States Marine Corps, Weapons Company, 2/4 Marine Infantry, and was not under control of U.S. Army Forces. As

2. On 28 Jun 04, this office received an allegation that Mr. [REDACTED] had been abused while detained at Ramadi Palace, Iraq (IZ). [REDACTED] alleged he was captured by U.S. Coalition Forces taken to a palace in Ramadi where is was hooded and handcuffed, then kicked and hit with the butt of a rifle in the back. During the course of the investigation it was established the U.S. Marine Corps (USMC) had operational control of the Ramadi area during the time frame of the alleged incident. Further, a review of the documentation provided by Detainee Operations, Camp Victory, IZ, detailed [REDACTED] was in the custody of the USMC, Weapons Company, 2/4 Marine Infantry Regiment until his transfer to Baghdad Central Correctional Facility (BCCF) on 18 Jun 04.

3. Around Oct 04, a request for assistance was dispatched to the NCIS. On 28 Jan 05, this office received an electronic message from SA [REDACTED] NCIS Little Creek, VA. SA [REDACTED] related the request for assistance received from our office had been completed and that NCIS Headquarters, Washington DC held the pertinent documents/information requested by this office. SA [REDACTED] was provided as the Point of Contact for this information. The report number was listed as 17OCT04-MEBJ-0472-7XMA. To date all attempts at contacting SA [REDACTED] have met with negative results. It is strongly believed that if the alleged offenses occurred they were perpetrated by members of the US Navy or Marine Corps. All US Army leads have been exhausted; therefore, this investigation is referred to the NCIS for action deemed appropriate.

The DATA consist of 7 CID agents. 1 Agent in Charge; 1 Senior Investigative Agent (Asst. Agent in Charge); 5 investigating agents (1 of which is a Warrant Officer). We presently have 72 open investigations. Five are Significant Data Files (SDF), and the remainders are Reports of Investigations (ROI). Of those ROIs, 5 pertain to U.S. Marines and 2 pertain to Naval Seals. We are required to provide a weekly update every Saturday to CID Command. The briefs are then provided on the hill in DC. Each update has to have current investigative activity within the present 7 day reporting period (Sunday - Saturday). We get reports via CID command, Abu Ghraib, the various Detention Facilities in the area, and from various units themselves. The primary efforts are trying to track people/units down. A lot are active duty, and reserves. Once they rotate out of country and return to their various locations, it then becomes a little tasking trying to locate the person/unit. At the present time, the only cases we have not been able to provide any valid investigative activity on are the ones noted above. I was informed by my Battalion Operations section that they are effecting coordination with NCIS, above our level, to discuss what you and I talked about, referring investigations. I am still awaiting a response.
