others. Previous BAU initiatives have focused on examining the behavioral traits of serial murderers, sexual sadists, rapists, arsonists, child abductors and school shooters. These projects have proven to be beneficial in many investigations. Although the BAU has historically provided assistance in domestic and international terrorism cases, the unit is now reorganized to address these and other matters, such as threat assessment, more intensely.

An expected outcome of this workshop is to incorporate your observations and insights into a comprehensive, experienced based guide for field agents and members of JTTFs. We are discussing the possibility of having both a classified and unclassified version, the latter of which could be shared with local police. In essence, all participants in this and possibly future workshops will become contributing authors to this product. Of course, as our experiences continue to evolve, we can expect to update this guide with revisions and modifications.

Interest in this workshop is high, but due to the nature of the workshop and space available, we cannot accommodate all who wish to attend.
