\* SECNAV Gordon England is at GTMO today accompanied by AGC [redacted] and host of others, including RADM McGarrah, who is in charge of the Office of Administrative Review for Detained Enemy Combatants (OARDEC - Combatant Status Review Tribunals and Administrative/Annual Review Boards)

\* OSC [redacted] attended a briefing with the SECNAV during which interagency support to the OARDEC was discussed. OSC [redacted] was given the opportunity to outline the FBI's support to OARDEC.

\* RADM McGarrah told the SECNAV that "the FBI is providing the model for all agencies to follow in supporting OARDEC." RADM McGarrah emphasized the FBI efficiency was based on our on-site review and approval process as opposed to CITF maintaining review and approval processes in Washington.

\* The SECNAV indicated he would engage CITF executives beginning 9/2 to streamline the review and approval process.
