Details: The author, [redacted] is a Special Agent of the FBI and served a tour at Guantanamo Bay, Cuba, from about 12/27/2002 through about 02/16/2004.

During the tour, the author conducted interviews of detainees in response to leads sent from FBI offices. At no time during the tour of duty at GTMO was any aggressive or inappropriate behavior directed towards detainees observed by the author.

The author is a former U.S. Army military police soldier, and is intimately familiar with how enemy prisoners of war, or other detained combatants, are to be treated. While assigned to GTMO, the author observed the soldiers conducting operations inside the facility where the detainees were located and it is the opinion of the author that these soldiers acted professionally and conducted their duties in the proper, prescribed fashion.
