Synopsis: To provide Inspection Division a negative response pursuant to requested information regarding GTMO detainee treatment.

Reference: E-mail dated 07/09/04 from Steven C. McCraw, Inspection Division.

Details: In referenced e-mail, Inspection Division requested all FBI agents assigned to Guantanamo Bay, Cuba (GTMO) to respond to questions regarding the observation of aggressive treatment, interrogations or interview techniques of detainees which was not consistent with Bureau interview policy/guidelines.

Writer was TDY to GTMO from 02/26/03 to 03/06/03, 03/26/03 to 04/08/03 and 05/04/03 to 05/14/03. Writer traveled to GTMO to primarily interview and maintain positive relationship with several high value detainees. Writer spent a minimum amount of time in Camp Delta and did not observe any behavior or actions which would be inconsistent with Bureau policy regarding interview policy/guidelines.
