(C) The Embassy has received a diplomatic note from the MFA dated February 19 that passed on the request of four attorneys for the families of the French detainees at Guantanamo to be allowed to visit the base (faxed to WE/EUR March 2; full text below). On March 3, press reports indicated that some of these attorneys, accompanied by the mayor of Venissieux (the Lyonnais suburban hometown of several of the detainees), representatives of the "Committee of Support to Families of Venissieux," and Colin Redgrave, will travel to the U.S. this weekend to present their concerns in Washington and at the UN in New York. We do not have additional information on their scheduled meetings.
