- 1. (U) This is an action message.
- (S) Posts are reminded that the NODIS caption is designed to protect the most sensitive information conveyed between posts and Washington. It means, with very few and specific exceptions, that there is no distribution to any other addressee other than the Department. In some cases, however, there may be compelling reasons to share postoriginated NODIS messages with other posts. The best way to have another post receive your NODIS message is to provide a suggested list of additional addressees in the first paragraph of your cable. The Department will make every effort to turn your request around quickly.
- 3. (C) Drawing on points in para 4, Embassy requested to inform host government at the earliest opportunity of information related to the transfer of their nationals to U.S facilities in Guantanamo Bay. nationals to U.S facilities in Guantanamo B Personal information on detainees in paragraph 5 may be given to the host government. We believe these individuals pose a threat to the United States and international peace and security. For operational and security reasons and to counter that threat as quickly as possible, we have transported them to the U.S. Naval Station at Guantanamo Bay.	
All detainees will be treated humanely.	
The United States is evaluating the possibility of prosecuting these detainees in a U.S. forum.	-
In evaluating the possibility of further legal action, any additional information your government can provide would be useful.	
If you have information concerning these detainees, and especially information concerning any criminal conduct (including violations of the laws of war) that they are alleged to have committed, we would appreciate receiving that information through the law enforcement liaison at our embassy.	
In addition, do you have any information from your own sources that connects these persons with al-Qaida or the Taliban?	
Are there any charges pending against these persons in your country? If so, what are those charges and against whom have they been brought?	
If pressed: We are studying the issue of allowing foreign governments access to detainees in Guantanamo Bay.
