MEDIA/OPINION ABROAD

1. THROUGH THE WEEKEND, INTERNATIONAL MEDIA ATTENTION SHIFTED RATHER ABRUPTLY FROM LAST WEEK'S G-8 DELIBERATIONS AND UN RESOLUTION 1546 TO THE SECURITY SITUATIONS ON THE GROUND IN IRAQ AND SAUDI ARABIA. (THE EUROPEAN UNION ELECTIONS ALSO GARNERED COMMENT). DESPITE WIDE COVERAGE OF THE ASSASSINATIONS IN IRAQ, COMMENTARY FOCUSED ON HUMAN RIGHTS TOPICS: ABU GHRAIB AND THE KILLING OF CIVILIANS IN U.S. AIR STRIKES.

IRAQ:

- -- THE GUARDIAN FEATURED A REPRINT OF A NEW YORK TIMES ARTICLE ON HUMAN RIGHTS WATCH'S CLAIM THAT THE U.S. DECISION TO GO FOR "HIGH-PROFILE" STRIKES AGAINST INDIVIDUAL IRAQI LEADERS EARLY IN THE WAR HAD "RESULTED IN DOZENS OF CIVILIAN CASUALTIES THAT THE U.S. COULD HAVE PREVENTED HAD IT TAKEN ADDITIONAL PRECAUTIONS."
