WASHINGTON, THOUGH HE DID NOT PROMISE AN ANSWER, NOTING THAT THE ICRC WAS THE USUAL CHANNEL FOR INFORMATION ABOUT DETAINEES. HE EXPLAINED THAT THOSE BEING HELD AT GUANTANAMO WERE DETAINED AS ILLEGAL COMBATANTS IN THE CONFLICT AGAINST TERRORISM THAT WAS STILL IN PROGRESS, AS HAS BEEN PUBLICLY REPORTED. THE US MILITARY WAS STILL INVESTIGATING THE ACTIVITIES OF THESE DETAINEES AND NO DETERMINATION HAD YET BEEN MADE ON WHETHER OR WHEN TO PROSECUTE THEM; THERE WAS NO WAY TO PREDICT HOW LONG THEY MIGHT BE DETAINED. POLCOUNS SAID HE HAD NO INFORMATION INDICATING THAT FAMILY MEMBERS WOULD BE ABLE TO VISIT THE DETAINEES, THAT EMBASSIES WOULD BE CONVEYING INFORMATION TO FAMILY MEMBERS, NOR THAT SOME DETAINEES MIGHT BE ABLE TO APPLY FOR FINANCIAL COMPENSATION SOMEDAY.
