DESPITE HAVING FADED SOMEWHAT FROM THE FRONT PAGES, THE UNITED STATES AND ITS COALITION PARTNERS ARE STILL FIGHTING A WAR AGAINST THE AL QAIDA NETWORK AND REMNANTS OF THE TALIBAN WHO CONTINUE TO SUPPORT THEM. THE AL QAIDA

NETWORK TODAY IS A MULTINATIONAL ENTERPRISE THAT MAINTAINS OPERATIONS IN MORE THAN 60 COUNTRIES. THE U.S. AND ITS PARTNERS ARE ENGAGED IN OPERATIONS IN AFGHANISTAN AND AROUND THE WORLD IN ORDER TO COUNTER THOSE WHO WOULD PLAN AND CONDUCT ATTACKS AGAINST US. IN THIS CONTEXT, OPERATIONAL AND SECURITY CONCERNS DO NOT ALLOW ME TO CONFIRM OR COMMENT ON THE CIRCUMSTANCES OF CAPTURE, TRANSFER OR DETENTION OF SPECIFIC INDIVIDUALS BELIEVED TO BE HELD AS ENEMY COMBATANTS IN THE COURSE OF THIS CONFLICT.

I ASSURE YOU THAT DESPITE THEIR LACK OF STATUS AS POWS UNDER THE THIRD GENEVA CONVENTION OF 1949, AL QAIDA AND TALIBAN DETAINEES WHO ARE DETAINED AS ENEMY COMBATANTS BY THE UNITED STATES ARMED FORCES ARE TREATED CONSISTENT WITH AMERICAN VALUES AND THE PRINCIPLES OF THE INTERNATIONAL LAW OF ARMED CONFLICT. AS PRESIDENT BUSH HAS STATED, THE UNITED STATES ARMED FORCES WILL TREAT ENEMY COMBATANTS HUMANELY AND IN A MANNER CONSISTENT WITH THE PRINCIPLES OF THE THIRD GENEVA CONVENTION OF 1949.

THE AUTHORITY TO DETAIN ENEMY COMBATANTS FOR THE DURATION OF HOSTILITIES EXISTS IN LAW INDEPENDENT OF THE CIVIL JUDICIAL OR CRIMINAL JUSTICE SYSTEM. IN THIS WAR, AS IN EVERY WAR, ENEMY COMBATANTS HAVE NO LEGAL RIGHT TO COUNSEL OR ACCESS TO COURTS FOR THE PURPOSE OF CHALLENGING THEIR DETENTION WHILE HOSTILITIES ARE ONGOING. WHILE SOME ENEMY COMBATANTS MAY FACE CRIMINAL PROSECUTION BEFORE THE END OF HOSTILITIES, NATIONS AT WAR TRADITIONALLY HAVE WAITED UNTIL HOSTILITIES CEASE TO BRING SUCH CHARGES. IF AND WHEN AN ENEMY COMBATANT IS CHARGED WITH A CRIME, HE

WOULD THEN BE ENTITLED TO LEGAL COUNSEL AND WOULD RECEIVE A FAIR TRIAL.

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REGARDING YOUR PROPOSAL OF A BRITISH PARLIAMENTARY VISIT TO GUANTANAMO, UNFORTUNATELY THIS WILL NOT BE

POSSIBLE. THE UNITED STATES MILITARY AUTHORITIES ONLY PERMIT VISITS BY FOREIGN GOVERNMENT OFFICIALS THAT ARE ESSENTIAL TO LAW ENFORCEMENT OBJECTIVES OR INTELLIGENCE GATHERING.
