1. SUMMARY: THIS CABLE PROVIDES POST WITH FORMAL GUIDANCE ON THE HANDLING OF INQUIRIES OF AFGHAN DETAINEES BY FAMILY MEMBERS. THIS GUIDANCE HAS BEEN APPROVED BY BOTH THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE AND DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE. THE DEPARTMENT IS AWARE THAT POST HAS BEEN FOLLOWING THESE GUIDELINES IN ANSWERING SUCH INQUIRIES, AND PROVIDES THIS

INFORMATION AS A FORMAL CONSOLIDATION FOR POST'S USE.

2. THE FOLLOWING GUIDANCE IS PROVIDED FOR HANDLING QUERIES ABOUT CONTACT OR COMMUNICATION THAT FAMILY MEMBERS OF DETAINEES IN US DOD CONTROL MAY HAVE WITH DETAINEES IN AFGHANISTAN OR AT GUANTANAMO.

3. THE INTERNATIONAL COMMITTEE OF THE RED CROSS (ICRC), WHICH HAS ACCESS TO DETAINEES AT BOTH LOCATIONS, PROVIDES INFORMATION ON THE HEALTH AND WELL BEING OF DETAINEES TO LOCAL ICRC OFFICES, WHICH INFORM FAMILIES.

4. ICRC ACCESS IS CONSISTENT WITH THE PRINCIPLES OF THE THIRD GENEVA CONVENTION, WHICH RECOGNIZES THE SPECIAL ROLE OF THE ICRC FOR PURPOSES OF ENSURING HUMANE TREATMENT AND MONITORING THE CONDITIONS OF THE DETAINEES.

5. DETAINED PERSONS HAVE BEEN AND WILL CONTINUE TO BE TREATED HUMANELY.
