

INVESTIGATIVE SUMMARY:

This investigation was initiated upon receipt of a Request for Investigation (RFI) 0178-04-CID001 from HQ, U.S. Army Criminal Investigation Command, Fort Belvoir, VA 22060-5506, to investigate allegations that SSG stole personal items from 676-5, 66-5 detainees (prayer beads) while he was deployed to Camp Delta Guantanamo Bay, Cuba.

Investigation established SSG did not commit the offense of Larceny when he

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took a set of prayer beads from the trash and was authorized to have the beads.

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


SUBJECT: Letter of Clarification

1. The purpose of this memorandum is to clear any misconceptions about prayer beads given to SSG during his tour at Guantanamo Bay, Cuba. 676-5166-5

2. I first met SSG when we were both assigned to the Joint Detention Operations Group (JDOG), Camp Delta, Joint Task Force Guantanamo. I served in the JDOG S2 and he served in the PSYOP Det adjacent to the S2. SSG was back-5, bb-5 always a consummate professional and took his job seriously at JTF GTMO.

3. The prayer beads from Guantanamo were a gift given by me on July 2003 prior to his departure. The beads were in a box the S2 deemed as unusable/junk. The box was the last place these items would see before they were trash. They were of no value except that of a centerpiece for discussion about the Global War on Terrorism - a simple piece of memorabilia.
