He continually suggests that the level of incompetence and political motivation hinder the FBI from effectively conducting investigations. He has criticized senior their handling of everything from interrogation to refusal from top management to allow information to be used," [redacted] advised [redacted] frequently had problems with his supervisors and often felt he was more dedicated than they were. [redacted] frequently tried to "back door things" as a SA. When asked to clarify [redacted] that phrase, [redacted] advised [redacted] as his SSA [redacted] and instead of working through [redacted] he frequently would go to [redacted] to obtain the necessary approvals.
